Sliding Fee Schedule (SFS)

Family is defined as: a group of two people or more (one of whom is the householder) related by birth, marriage or adoption and residing together; all such people (including related subfamily members) are considered as members of one family. Any and all income must be reported, i.e., earnings, unemployment compensation, workers' compensation, Social Security, public assistance, veterans' payments, survivor benefits, pension or retirement income, interest, etc.
